C F² C F² (continue same chord riff)

(hold index and little fingers on 1st & 2nd strings)

Verse/Chorus

C F² C

F G F

G C F² (prepare little finger on 1st string)

Am G F C Repeat Verse/Chorus & end on C

Having trouble getting chords & rhythm together?

This is a great song for developing guitarists; it is a good example of using C with F2 - the C needs to be played with the little finger included on the 1st string (use this version of C throughout the song). Songs in the key of C tend to be difficult for learner guitarists until the chord of F is under control. Fortunately, F2 is easier but you do also need the F bar-chord.

All the chords used in *Angel of Harlem* are introduced in *Modern Guitar Chord Styles, Volume 1* - it's the best rhythm guitar book you'll find to help learn all about chords, strumming, rhythm reading and special techniques like open-chord changes, staccato strums, bar-chords, and more. It contains plenty of familiar sounding chord progression examples to aid your learning and includes a sample of each on the play-along CD.
