Having trouble getting chords and rhythm together?

Get Lucky is a cool example of Funk rhythm but it's really an Electric guitar piece: Funk is an Electric style and progressions like this are hard work for the left hand on acoustic guitars. Also, funk is an advanced rhythm style: syncopated sixteenths represent advanced counting ability.

To learn about Funk rhythm techniques, chord forms and reading check out **Modern Guitar Chord Styles, Volume 3** - an advanced text dealing with Jazz and Funk chords, rhythms and generic styles: a must for serious students.
