Handy hints

The F major7 (that's what the triangle indicates) is not a bar-chord: place your index finger on the 6th string, and your 2nd finger on the second string and be sure to mute the 5th string but allow the 1st string to ring clearly. This version of F^Δ7 is better in a progression like this because it features the F bass note as the lowest note of the chord. To improve your chord knowledge and rhythm ability check out *Modern Guitar Chord Styles, Volume I* - the best rhythm guitar book available.
