### Handy hints

Three-string power-chords give a stronger tone; professionals favour these but the two-string forms will suit this song. *Rolling In The Deep* features palm-muted downstrokes throughout the song: keep your strumming wrist relaxed and light on the bridge otherwise your hand will tire before the song is finished.
