Having trouble getting chords and rhythm together?

Scar is a great example of acoustic rhythm guitar; listen to how steady the rhythm is in the original. The down and upstrokes need to be played in the order shown here to get that effect. The bar-chord of **F** is likely to be your main problem; if you're not already comfortable with it will need some patient practice before you can use it in songs. Although the basic form of F Major will work, the bar-chord form will sound better. To learn more about bar-chords, chord changing and strumming techniques and heaps more, check out *Modern Guitar Chord Styles, Volume 1* - its the best rhythm guitar book you'll find & will prove very helpful for you.
