This beautiful ballad is a great progression for developing guitarists; it has an interesting progression with a good variety of chords and can be strummed with a basic rhythm, or finger-picked similar to the original. The original version is in the key of D - play this chart with a capo at the 2nd fret to create this.

It's got heaps of info about strumming, rhythm reading and techniques like open-chord changes, bar-chords, finger-picking, using a capo, and more.
