### Having trouble getting the chords & rhythm together?

This is the original version of *The First Cut Is The Deepest* but many will know the 1970s Rod Stewart version better. Rod's is in the key of C Major - to play it use C for G, F for C, and G for D. All the chords, strumming and picking techniques shown in this chart are introduced in **Modern Guitar Chord Styles, Volume 1** - the best rhythm guitar book you'll find. It has heaps of info about strumming, rhythm reading and techniques like open-chord changes, staccato strums, bar-chords, and plenty of familiar sounding progression examples to help you develop your playing.
